
#### So now would be a great time for you to get involved!

We'll be back to consult with you, and various consultative bodies, on the detailed Draft Plan and are aiming to get the finalised Plan submitted to Cornwall Council immediately after the New Year.

**Finally** the finished NNP will be put to the local residents in a referendum. Only if you vote YES to accept the plan will it be adopted by Cornwall Council and carry weight in planning law.

ack in October last year the Newquay Neighbourhood Plan team issued a detailed questionnaire to every house in the parish asking for your views on what a future Newquay and surrounding area should look like.

The questionnaire was part of a series of public consultation events that are being used to shape policies that will form the basis of our Newquay Neighbourhood Plan (NNP).

The NNP will give local people more of a say on what kind of development should be allowed in the town and where it should or should not be built.

It will allow you to decide what the town centre should look like. What emphasis we should put on protecting our natural environment, heritage and green spaces. How we might improve public transport, the infrastructure of the town and leisure facilities.
